



Castor Church of England Primary School

Pupil Premium funding 2018-19

Each year the school receives Pupil Premium funding from the Government. This is a sum of money that is allocated to the school based on the number of children who are identified as 'disadvantaged children' or 'service children'.

Funding for these children in the academic year 2018/19 is as follows:

Disadvantaged children (incl. Ever6)	£1320 per child
Looked after children / Post looked after children	£1900 per child
Service children (incl. Ever6)	£300 per child

The purpose of this funding is to raise the progress and attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities and to close the gaps between these children and their peers.

Contextual information

Castor Church of England Primary School is a one-form entry school with a Pupil Admission Number (PAN) of 26 in each year group. In total, we have 178 children on roll, organised into 7 single age year group classes.

We have a relatively small number of children in receipt of Pupil Premium, and as such, the individual needs and characteristics of these children are quite different. It is important to note that of our 18 children eligible for the funding, 11 children are identified as 'disadvantaged' children and 7 are identified as 'service' children. A further important consideration is that 7 of the 18 children (39%) are also prior lower attainers.

Allocated Funding	Planned Expenditure
£11534	Intervention sessions and class based support from Teaching Assistants in Literacy and Numeracy for PP children in Reception to Year 6 throughout the year. Children in receipt of Pupil Premium who are at risk of 'falling behind' will be targeted for these sessions
£1270	1 x Teaching Assistant to lead Sensory circuits from 8:15am. This encourages children to be in school and on time, with an active start to their school day.
£1200	School trips including residential visits
£500	Uniform
£880	Curriculum- swimming, music
